

I would be remiss if I did not thank Nancy McMillin, D.G.M., for all her kindness and good advice during this term. I really appreciated all the help she gave to me.



Finally, our appreciation goes to Bob Martelet who has done a fine job as editor of "The Masonic Bulletin."


