
"Sarge" Hicks is home after his surgery at the Cleveland Clinic. We miss him here. Take care Sarge!

This is a change that I think is a great idea. The Commander, if worthy, will receive his "Certificate of Completion" at the end of the year.


Old Business: The recorder explained the Commandery was under the impression that the Grand Commandery per capita increase, from \$3.10 to \$10.00 was to take place next year. We recently found out that the increase is THIS year. To this end, we are proposing and dues increase of \$6.90 plus an additional \$2.10 to amortize over three + years to cover this increase. The motion was made in the form of an amendment, which was approved by Sir Knight Wiley, seconded by Sir Knight Haines. The motion passed. A copy of the amendment is attached below.

Ie. We previously payed \$12.10/25.00 to Grand Commandery and Grand Encampment. Last year we paid \$19.00/25.00 to Grand Commandery and Grand Encampment, with no increase in dues. The Commandery covering the \$7.00 increase. This will increase the dues to \$34.00 per year to cover the increased per capita and amortize the amount we covered for the members.

No vote is necessary since our by-laws allow us to automatically increase

dues to match increased per capita taxes. This motion is merely courtesy to allow members opportunity to voice their opinions.
