A Forgotten Benefit of Masonry

One of the privileges or benefits of Masonry, often forgotten, is the right to a Masonic Funeral Service. This service may be performed for any deceased brother in good standing who shall have requested it or is requested by his family or any persons standing in as the nearest relationship.

Often the family is not aware of this service or the wishes of the deceased for this service. Most Funeral Directors are aware of it and will ask the family if they wish a service if, he is aware the deceased is a Mason. But too often his Masonic membership is never mentioned.

There is a funeral request form available for the asking and any lodge secretary will be glad to assist in this request. It is also advisable for the member to write locations of his: "Last Will and Testament" and White Lambskin Apron. It is wise to plan for this and foolish to neglect.






