

November is nominations of officer's month at the Grotto. Any Prophet interested in becoming a line officer and sitting on stage, please be present at the November Stated Meeting.





There was a banquet that evening with the two days concluding with the installation of the new Grand Officers


installation of the new Grand Officers and a few inspiring words from the new Grand Illustrious Master.


We would really like to see you at our meetings and some inspections.
