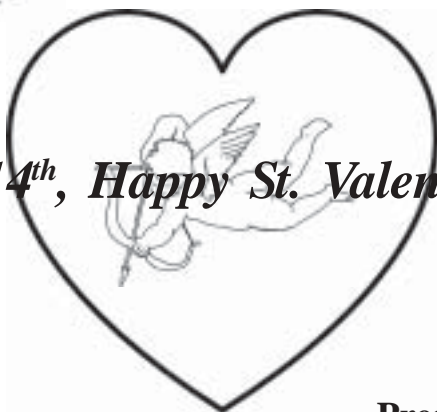

United Grand Lodge History by: Dr. Anderson

It is fitting but still hard to believe that the humble beginning of Speculative Masonry's birth was on the second floor of a London Tavern but, on the 24th day of June, 1717, four fledging London Lodges, who had existed for some time, came together at the "Goose and Gridiron Tavern" in St Paul's Churchyard, declared themselves a Grand Lodge and elected Anthony Sayer as their Grand Master. This was the first Grand Lodge ever and chartered many lodges throughout the world. The four Lodges which effected the formation of the Premier Grand Lodge are referred to as: "The Four Old Lodges." They were known by the names of the taverns or ale houses where they met. The distinction between ale-houses and taverns, if any, is probably inconsequential. Dr. Anderson lists the "Four Old Lodges" as:

1. **At the Goose and Gridiron Ale-house in St. Paul's Churchyard.**
2. **At the Crown Ale-house in Parker's Lane near Drury Lane.**
3. **At the Apple-Tree Tavern in Charles Street, Covent Garden.**
4. **At the Rummer and Grapes Tavern in Channel Row, Westminster.**

Saturday, June 24th, St. John the Baptist Day, 2017, the 21st Masonic District will celebrate the 300 year Tercentennial of the United Grand Lodge of England. Details are still in committee! (Picture on page 11)
