





Yesteryear Trivia

In the late 1700s many houses consisted of a large room with only one chair. Commonly, a long wide board was folded down from the wall and used for dining. The "head of the household" always sat in the chair while everyone else ate sitting on the floor. Once in a while an invited guest would be offered to sit in this chair during a meal (who was almost always a man). To sit in the chair meant you were important and in charge. Sitting in the chair, one was called the "chair man." Today in business we use the expression/title "Chairman or Chairman of the Board".



Greetings Sir Knights! November is looking to be a very busy month for us and I am looking forward to every event invite as a chance to show everyone, what we as Knights Templars are partially about; so your support in the above activities is highly encouraged. We have some practices that have been completed and the response and participation makes me smile. We are in the process, along with Chapter and Council, looking into the roles of the lodges to see if any Sir Knights need help or even if they have passed to the celestial lodge; so if you are contacted that will be the reason. Grand Commandery was a truly amazing experience and I am so glad I attended. I must tell you I am excited about this year with every meeting and every practice.

In 1779 the High Knights Templar of Ireland Lodge, Kilwinning, obtained a charter from Lodge Mother Kilwinning in Scotland. This lodge now began to grant dispensations to other lodges to confer the Knights Templar Degree. Sometime around 1790 the Early Grand Encampment of Ireland was formed, which began to warrant Templar Lodges, and evolved into the Supreme Grand Encampment in 1836. The Early Grand Encampment chartered several Scottish "encampments;" one of which, having been chartered in 1805 as the "Edinburgh Encampment No. 31," then became the" Grand Assembly of Knights Templar in Edinburgh," who then sought a charter from the Duke of Kent, Grand Master of the Order in England. It seems that the Templar Degree **Continued on page 9**

had filtered into the lodges of the Antients from Ireland about 1780, and was recorded at York about the same time. In the five degree system developed by the York Masons, the Knights Templar Degree sat between the Master Mason and the Sublime Degree of Royal Arch.
