





It is a movement to create an international day of charitable giving at the beginning of the Christmas and Holiday season. Giving Tuesday was started in 2012 by the 92nd Street "Y" and the United Nations Foundation as a response to commercialization and consumerism in

the post-Thanksgiving season such as "Black Friday" and "Cyber Monday." The date range is November 27th to December 3rd and is always five days after the U.S. Thanksgiving Holiday.





Pearl Harbor Memorial

The Date of Infamy that launched an epic conflict with Japan took place here in the early morning hours of December 7, 1941. The tranquil waters of Pearl Harbor were forever disrupted by the tides of war. The USS Arizona and 1,177 of her crew were among the first casualties of the Pacific War; the USS Arizona Memorial stands above the sunken vessel and her fallen sailors, serving as a reminder of their sacrifice and commitment.
