
Please Prophets come on out to our meetings. We have some great fundraisers in the mix but we need help. Help us plan and execute these events.

To my brethren and their families: I wish you my best. I hope you are all well and happy and remember to "Make Freemasonry Real!"



The Term "Lewis" Regarding Masonry

Masonry, as you well know has a ton of symbols referring to lessons taught by the Master's. Only one Grand Lodge in America recognizes the Lewis as a symbol. The Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania recognizes the Lewis as a Masonic symbol of subtle strength in as an older Master Masons son is referred to as a Lewis assuming he will assist his father with strength in ladder years. The word Lewis may come from Latin words meaning to levitate or it could have been the inventor's name. Most other Grand Lodges use the color red to symbolize subtle strength. The Lewis is a tool that utilizes the strength of gravity to obtain its purpose. You like myself, probably have wondered how the Operative Masons moving large stones into position by means of slings, ropes, block-antackle, got the slings and rope from under the stone. Well this is where the Lewis came into play. The Craftsman of the stone would cut a Lewis Hole in the stone close to the center of gravity. This rectangular hole with tapered ends larger at the bottom would utilize the Lewis for lifting short distance. The Lewis consisted of three plates of iron connected to a top ring the outside two plates larger at the bottom. With the center plate removed it could be inserted into the Lewis Hole and the center plate was than reinstalled. When the ring was lifted the weight of the stone caused the load to force the wedges out thus grasping the stone. The Lewis was never intended to move large stones long distances or to great heights; obviously the slightest shifting of weight would cause the Lewis to disengage with resulting disaster below. Its intention was only to lift the weight enough to allow removal of slings while mortar was placed. The Lewis Hole was than plugged with the Lewis Plug supplied be the Craftsman. The operative Lewis came in three classes; the wedge, described above; the pin type where holes were drilled into the stone angled towards each other at the bottom. When pins connected to a lifting ring were inserted; lifting caused the pins to bind snagging the stone. Also the tong type (number three) used today in steel and railroad industry. Tongs connected to a lifting ring caused the weight to force the teeth together or apart as they were designed. Two men can lift and move very easily a large tie into position using the Railroad Lewis. In Speculative Masonry, to some, the Lewis is a symbol of the final tool assisting

to place that living stone into that house not made of hands, eternal in the heavens. Mc LEO
