The Cable Tow

Masonry has many symbols which remind us of our obligation to our craft. One of which will have a great impact on this fraternity in the coming months, when this pandemic is finally brought under control: is the “cable tow.” You may remember the application of the “cable tow” in the Entered Apprentice Degree, where if the candidate will not conform to the edicts and laws of the lodge, he may be removed by use of this symbol; keeping the brethren in relative safety. This could be considered its first use although in the Fellow Craft Degree, the “cable tow” is used more as a unit of measure. One could relate to the Old English maritime use of the term cable and fathom referring to the depth of water under the ships keel ... or such as: within the length of your “cable tow;” the second reference to this symbol. But perhaps and most important meaning of this symbol will accrue in the coming months, when this pandemic is behind us and lodge will get back to a more normal existence with brethren starting to meet in Blue Lodges again. The “Cable Tow” will take on new meaning as that connection, that link or thread, that yearning for camaraderie, that feeling of obligation to your lodge and Freemasonry, which will hopefully drive you back to your lodge meetings and bring attendance and face-to-face meetings back to where they were before Covit-19! Remembering that a cable is a network of threads, usually steel, wound of braded together to form a flexible unit the strength of which is the sum total of all components; and to tow is to move an object against the will a gravity; which will define the third and probably the most important use of this symbol of brotherly love. The “Cable Tow” is strictly a Masonic term and symbol and has its own life and meaning.
