April is one of the Holiest months with Holy Week and ending with Easter Sunday, along with Passover.



Your Lodge Secretaries could use your help!!

Brethren, good communication is something that will benefit us all at every level both personally and professionally. In Masonry, there are many communications that emanate from the Grand Lodge via Grand View and 99.99% of them are sent electronically. To ensure that the Brethren of the Canton Masonic Temple are kept abreast of these informative communications, your Lodge Secretaries and I are working together to close the gap between Brothers who are "active" on Grand View with those Brothers who have not signed up yet.

Here is our **FIRST** ask, if you are already signed up in Grand View, simply login and verify your information, correcting anything that might not be accurate. For those of you that are NOT currently set up in Grand View please follow these step by step instructions.

If you are **NOT** set up in Grand View here comes our **SECOND** ask.

- **1.** Access the Grand View system at https://oh.grandview.system
- 2. Upper right hand corner of the screen, click on Member Portal
- **3.** When you land on the Member Portal page, there are 2 selections: "**Sign On**" and "**Member Registration**" (click on Member Registration)
- **4.** The **Membership Registration** will appear. Fill in the requested info
- 5. Enter your Lodge number NO extra zeros! (60, 431 or 710)
- **6.** Member Id # from your dues card. Do not us the "M" or any of the leading zeroes. **M0001234 would be entered as 1234**
- 7. Last Name EXACTLY as it shows on your dues card
- **8.** Click on the Membership Status button, a second page will be displayed. Enter your email address and a MINIMUM 8 letter password. (Remember your passwrod as it is unique to you.) Click on "submit" to enter your information, that's it!!
- **9.** You are now a registered user of Grand View, please double check your information and if needed make corrections.
