





A Council is similar, in many ways, to a Masonic Lodge; it has officers and a ritual degree system which in this case consists of three degrees: Royal Master, Select Master, and Super Excellent Master. The Super Excellent Master's Degree is optional in some jurisdictions. The various positions in the lodge are modeled directly after Craft Masonry and though the names are often different, the duties are largely the same. Their seating is a bit different, however, in that all three principal officers of a Council sit on the East dais, while the Captain of the Guard and Conductor of the Council sit in the west and south.

Canton Masonic Association Canton Masonic Temple Reservation Policy

Many questions have been raised with regards to the policies and procedures for reserving space with the Canton Masonic Temple. In an attempt to clarify, please be advised of the following:

The rooms/spaces typically requested and reserved within the Temple include: the Cathedral Room, Cryptic Room, Blue Lodge, Auxiliary Blue Lodge, Ballroom, 2M conference room and Auxiliary Dining Room. Other spaces are available and will be addressed on an as needed basis.

The official (and only one that matters) calendar, resides with the Canton Masonic Association under the control of the Secretary/Treasurer. Efforts are underway to make the calendar available online in a "view only" mode and the tenant bodies will be made aware of its availability when implemented.

All tenant bodies requesting use of a space/room within the Temple must contact Gary Dressler at garyd@sssnet.com, to check/verify availability of the same.

All requests for reservations must be in writing (a new three-part form is currently being printed.) Gary can put a temporary hold on a space pending the receipt of the "reservation form" but the reservation is not official until the paperwork is received.

Tenant bodies automatically have their respective regular meeting location reserved for "Stated" Meetings. All other meetings/events require a separate reservation form i.e., "Specials", Installations/Inspections, practices, fundraisers, etc. Blanket reservations will not be approved.

Any request for use of the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite spaces will require the approval of the Executive Secretary, or his designee of the AASR. The new form will reflect this requirement.

The use of Temple space by Masonic tenant bodies for Masonic events is included in the bodies "quarterly maintenance fees". Non-tenant body Masonic events i.e., Grand Lodge, OES, MW&D, other non-resident Masonic bodies, etc. must follow the same procedure as outlined above and may be subject to a rental fee.

Non-Masonic events i.e., weddings, parties, outside fundraisers, Boy Scout and HOF activities, etc. are under the direction of Diane Phillips, phillipsdlk@gmail.com. All reservations, police protection, catering, special requirements, health department involvement, etc. are under her area of responsibility. The rental fees will be coordinated through Diane with the support of the CMA.

As our Masonic membership continues to decline, the non-Masonic events,

and the rental fees generated from the same are the future of the Temple and all Brothers are encouraged to promote the use of the Temple with friends, family members, business contacts, outside organizations, etc. A Masonic discount is available for non-Masonic events like a daughter's wedding, a grandchild's birthday, an anniversary party, etc. The new restrooms in the Ballroom have added significantly to the ease of hosting a party/event. Your involvement in promoting the Temple is gratefully encouraged.

"Reservation for Rooms Forms" are available in the hall across from the Temple Mailboxes or in the Building Managers office when open.

Should there be any comments, questions or concerns about any of the above, please reach out to me or one of the board members of the CMA representing all Masonic bodies in the Temple. I thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Mardi Gras

Mardi Gras, or Fat Tuesday, refers to events of the Carnival celebration, beginning on or after the Christian feasts of the Epiphany (Three Kings Day) and culminating on the day before Ash Wednesday, which is known as Shrove Tuesday. Mardi Gras is French for "Fat Tuesday", reflecting the practice of the last night of eating rich, fatty foods before the ritual Lenten sacrifices and fasting of the Lenten season.

Related popular practices are associated with Shrovetide celebrations before the fasting and religious obligations associated with the penitential season of Lent. In countries such as the United Kingdom, Mardi Gras is more usually known as Pancake Day or (traditionally) Shrove Tuesday (derived from the word shrive, meaning "to administer the sacrament of confession.
